The main things your child will be learning and developing are: -

- Talking about different types of machines
- Building models with construction toys
- Designing machines and constructing machines in our Workshop role play area
- Exploring puppets from traditional fairy tales
- Counting using objects (nursery)
- Careful counting and labelling sets with numerals (reception)
- Continuing and making repeating patterns (reception)
- Experimenting with mark making (nursery)
- Writing their own name with correct letter formation (reception)
- Blending and segmenting CVC words (reception)
- Recognising the sounds qu v j w x y z sh ch th ng || ff zz (reception)
- Learning to read keywords and guided reading books (reception)
- Developing social skills for sharing, participating, turn taking
- Developing speaking and listening skills

You can help by:-

1. Talking to your child about machines you can find around the home

- 2. Counting objects with your child. Talking about repeating patterns and making patterns with objects.
- 3. Encouraging your child to draw and write at home ensuring they hold their pencil with a three finger grip, close to the point. (nursery and reception)
- 4. Reading with your child and practicing their keywords(reception) and ensuring their reading folder comes into school every day (nursery and reception)
- 5. Talking to your child about what they have done during the day.
- 6. Talking to your child about their favourite fairy tale
