English

- We will also be writing instructions on how to be a bad or good wolf.



Computing: What is a computer?

- We will learn the different parts of a computer.
- We learn how we can use a computer for different tasks.

RE: What do Christians believe God is like?

- We will be reading stories that help to understand how Christian feel about God.
- We will be learning our to use forgiveness to be better friends.

PE: Fundamental skills 2

- We will develop our throwing and catching techniques.
- We will learn how to use our balance effectively.

PSHE: Me and My Relationships

- We will be learning about our emotions and strategies to deal with them.
- We will also keep learning how to be a good friend.

Science: Animals including Humans (Growth)

- We will learn what animals and human need to survive.
- We will learn the stages of human life cycles.
- We will learn how exercise, diet and hygiene keep our bodies healthy.
- We will learn how to research and investigate scirtific enquir-ies such as 'How does exercise effect heart rate ?' and How can washing out hands prevent the spread of germs?'

Maths: Place Value, addition and subtraction

- We will learn the value of numbers to 100 and partition them into tens and ones.
- We will recall our number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.
- We will use addition and subtraction to solve problems.
