Reception Class-September 2026

If your child will be 4 years old before 1st September 2026, you will need to apply for a Reception Class place. The deadline for applications is **Thursday 15th January 2026**.

Applications must be made via Rochdale Council's Parent Portal. If your child attends our Nursery Class, you will still need to apply

Nursery Places

We have places available in our Nursery Class. If your child will turn 3 before **1st January**, they could start after the Christmas Holiday.

For children who will be 3 before **1st April**, there will be places available following the Easter break.

We are also accepting applications for September 26, for children who will be 3 before **1st September 26**.

We have 15 & 30 hour options, and Nursery children are able to access our Breakfast & After School Clubs.
