Breakfast/After School Club

Bookings went live via Arbor in September. If you need a place, it **MUST** be booked on Arbor. We will no longer be adding children based on historic arrangements.

The cut off for booking a place is 24 hours before the session. If you need to book after this please call or email, there is an additional fee of 50p for same day bookings.

If your child is not booked on via Arbor, but arrives on the day, or is not collected on time at the end of the school day, you will be charged the additional 50p fee.

Uniform

Please ensure your children are coming to school in the correct uniform and school shoes rather than trainers.

P.E

Children need to come into school in their PE kit on their PE day. Please make sure that they have a change of footwear for indoor PE, these can be either pumps or white soled trainers if you have them.

Jewellery

For safety reasons only small studs are permitted in school, these **must** be removed for PE & sports activities rather than being taped. Bracelets/necklaces should not be worn in school.

Texts

We have phased out texts as a means of communication, and will no longer be send any texts in the near future unless urgent. Arbor is our main means of communicating with parents and families, so please ensure you are able to log in and have notifications enabled.

All trips will be on Arbor by Monday. You must give consent via the trips section of your child's account. Payments are also made via Arbor.

You will receive a message on Arbor with a link to a Microsoft form, which must be completed stating whether your child needs a school packed lunch or not.

Although we love seeing your pets, unfortunately we cannot allow them on the school site.

Only staff cars and blue badge holders are allowed onto the school drive and car park. This is to keep our pedestrian community safe.
